## Free Self-Defense and Safety Event

You are invited to a free 45-minute self-defense lesson Wed., Jan. 5, at 7 PM Held at the Fellowship Hall of Oak Meadow United Methodist Church at 2740 Hunters Green. Sponsored by the Oak Meadow COP, the Oak Meadow Homeowners Association and the Castle Hills Forest Homeowners Association, A free forty-five minute interactive self-defense class, will be conducted by Olaf Henderson, an extremely well-qualified instructor who works with Northeast Independent School District.
