SWIM TEAM

I hope everyone had a wonderful holiday season. Wow....I can't believe we are in 2011 and are thinking about Swim Team again! I can't wait to see the results of our pool. **Thank You Neighbors!!** Without your donations and support, our Swim Team would not exist. It will be very exciting to swim in our new pool this year.

REGISTRATION WILL BE APRIL 2ND THIS YEAR. Anyone registering later than April 15th, will incur a late fee of \$10 per swimmer. In the past, several swimmers register the week of swim practice. This makes it very difficult for me to assess our teams, determine how much help we will need, be available to first-time parents, and help organize the coaches to ensure adequate first week training. **Please mark your calendars** and pay your HOA dues now. This will really help make things run more smoothly.

Beginner Program - This program will be offered for the month of May for \$80.00. (HOA dues must be current). This will be open for all first-time swimmers from ages 4 to 10. This program allows our coaches to focus more on our beginners with the intent of moving them to our Swim Team. WE WANT YOUR SWIMMER. Your child will learn how to feel comfortable in the water, how to use a kickboard, and how to swim freestyle across the pool. Depending on their progress, additional strokes will be taught. If your beginner is interested in joining our Swim Team, they must successfully complete our program and must be at least 5 years of age. (Age requirement is per the LSSSL). An additional fee of \$10 will be charged to add your swimmer to our Swim Team roster.

Swim Team - Coach Haley, Coach Travis, and Coach Corbin have all confirmed they are returning to our team this year. The registration cost will remain at \$80.00. We





POOL RENOVATIONS

I'm sure many of you have noticed the work going on at our pool. This work is the result of our fundraising efforts this past summer. Work began in November and should be completed by the time you receive this newsletter. Let me share with you what exactly is being done.

- 1. Install no diving signs on the deck
- 2. Install depth markings on the deck and at the tile line
- 3. New drains to meet VGB Act
- 4. Re-plaster both pools
- 5. Separation tile between shallow and deep ends
- 6. Separation tiles on steps
- 7. Install new exit and handrail
- 8. Install new handrail on steps in shallow end

To celebrate this huge renovation to the pool the Board will be holding a Polar Bear Swim in February. The date has yet to be determined, but watch for signs announcing this event. It should be a lot of fun!
